SPECIFICS - BASKETBALL

1. FACILITIES

1.1. Technical installations

- A minimum number of 3 FIBA approved full size pitches with all the regulation line markings.
- The courts must be distinctively separate and if possible with a dividing curtain.

1.2. Ancillary facilities

- dressing rooms with toilets and showers,
- dressing room for the referees,
- room for tournament organizers
- room to be used as clinic.

2. TECHNICAL EQUIPMENT

2.1. Specific materials

In every Basketball court there must be:

- table and chairs for the scorer, the timekeeper, the 24-second operator and the OTI,
- 2 chairs for substitutes,
- 1 stop, 1 whistle, score sheets,
- 2 red flags or lights for team fouls,
- foul marker indicators,
- electronic or manual scoreboard,
- benches or chairs for both teams,
- 6 warm up balls of the same supplier as per game ball (3 balls for each team).

2.2. Miscellaneous equipment

- brush and mop to wipe the floor,
- pole protections.

2.3. Administrative materials

- fixtures for matches should be shown on gym notice board,
- a minimum of 2 colored pens (red and black) for the scoresheets.

3. STAFF

3.1. Local responsible + deputy

3.2. Table staff

- scorekeeper,
- timekeeper,
- 24 second operator,
- a referee responsible (in case of young referees). Each match we need 2 official referees. In case of young referees they will be integrated in agreement with the OTI.

3.3. Auxiliary staff

- one manager per field,
- a cloakroom responsible,
- a person in charge of the service or order,
- a responsible of facilities and equipment,
- a head of the medical service.

4. PROGRESS OF THE COMPETITION

According to the general regulations of the FISEC of the collective sports, the specific regulations of the FISEC basketball are governed by the regulations of the FIBA.
